However he was sent back and was mustard gassed again a second time. After the war when he returned home he had to sleep outside in some kind of vent arrangement to get the fresh aid he needed to recover." (source: Albert's granddaughter)

**Mustard Gas** (Yperite) was first used by the <u>German Army</u> in September 1917. It was one of the most lethal of all the poisonous chemicals used during the war. It was almost odourless and took twelve hours to take effect.(www.spartacus-educational.com/FWWmustard.htm)
