## Military & War service:

Private, No 6547, 1st Norfolk, 1903 Served in Gibraltar, South Africa and France

In the 1911 Census Samuel's occupation appears as "Soldier – pensioner, army" but it seems he must have signed up again.

He served in the British Expeditionary Force in France from 14<sup>th</sup> August 1914. He was taken prisoner of war and held at the POW camp in Wahn, Germany.

• Wahn. Located 20 miles south-east of Cologne at the Wahner Heide Artillery practice camp. The camp has 35,000 men on its register and was formerly a parent camp for work camps in the district. (source: Wikipedia)

It appears he was repatriated 14<sup>th</sup> September 1917 and discharged as "Being no longer physically fit for war service"

(mentioned in November 1914 parish magazine and appears on the Neatishead Victory Hall 'returned' list)
