- Born:** 5<sup>th</sup> October 1895 in Neatishead, Norfolk
- Baptised:** 24<sup>th</sup> December 1895 Neatishead Church
- Parents:** Father: David Henry Plummer (1865–1941)  
Mother: Mary Elizabeth Annie Spooner (1862-1923)  
married 6<sup>th</sup> November 1893 in Norwich
- Sibling:** Gladys Charlotte Elthea (1898–1980)
- Schooling:** Neatishead School – Charles and his sister Gladys were awarded medals, certificates and postcards for excellent attendance
- 1901 census:** Aged 5, living in Lessingham, Norfolk
- 1911 census:** Aged 15, living in Neatishead.  
Occupation listed as a farm labourer
- Marriage:** None, but engaged to Millicent Maud Blake

**Death:** 13<sup>th</sup> April 1918, aged 22  
**Burial:** Ploegsteert Memorial, Belgium. Also on parents gravestone in St Peter's Churchyard, Neatishead

**Military & War service:** Private Charles Henry Plummer  
18444, 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion, Coldstream Guards.

**Medals:** Victory, British
